	*Nirsevimab				Influenza vaccine every year starting at age 6 months. 2 doses are required during the first season.							

1: Pentacel is a combination vaccine including: DTaP, Polio, and Hib

2: Meningococcus given at 11 and 16 yrs is for types ACWY. A second Meningococcal vaccine may be provided at 17-18 yrs for type B.

3: HPV is a 2-3 dose series depending on when the first dose was administered

COVID vaccines will be made available as recommended by doctors and scientists that are evaluating the data

\*Nirsevimab is a monoclonal antibody and may be given to babies < 8 months of age at parent request between October 1st and March 31st
